This project is great fun, and if you bring items to share we can build off each others ideas! You can embellish this as much you want, and still be able to fold it for transport or off season storage.

General

Sewing machine with zigzag capability

Open-toed embroidery foot and zipper foot for your machine

80/12 topstitch sewing machine needles

Polyester monofilament thread or thread to match your house fabric & rattail

Pencil or pen for tracing pattern

rotary cutter, mat & ruler

Iron & ironing surface (Omnigrd makes a nice folding cutting & ironing surface called Fold-a-Way)

Embellishments

1 yard beaded or tasseled ribbon trim (1 ½ for large house)

3 yards Rattail cording

Lace, metallic netting, photos on fabric, or ??? for the windows

Embellishing fabric, paints and other embellishments (your imagination is the limit)

 Rick-rack, glitzy fabric, striped fabric - see roofing ideas in the book

 Aileen's Jewel it glue, buttons, glitter dimensional paint, paint on snow

Seasonal items available at craft stores - snowflakes &

Fabric & Interfacing

1 yard heavyweight fast2fuse (or 1 yd Timtex and 2 additional yards Wonder Under)

2 yards fusible web

1 yard of fabric for house - you can use different fabric for the walls and roof if desired.

½ yard fabric for base

Fat quarter of fabric for trees if making them
